Agenda 4

To Discuss and decide upon the proposals received by SGDMF(T)

1. Request from Chetna Education Society for Disable Friendly buses and steel net for school compound. (Rs.31,74,600 for Bus) (Rs.8,75,000 for netting).

The Chetna Education School caters the areas like Sanvordem, Dharbandora, Quepem, Sanguem and Curchorem. The School has submitted quotation for Force Monobus 4020 mm WB F-M 2-6 CR BS 6.2 33+D PS/HBS with ABS. Almost 175 students are enrolled. Currently 4 buses are running at a cost of almost 2.5 lakh per month and many of these are on rental basis. The school has requested for the bus that will reduce the transportation cost.

Decision: The Chairperson approved only the project of bus procurement after considering the opinions of the Managing Committee and recommended it to GC for its consideration.

2. Scholarship for mining Engineering students at Goa College of Engineering, Farmagudi.

The proposals directly received from Goa College of Engineering in proposal format. The project proposes an amount of ₹1.6 crores over a period of 7 years. The proposal outlines sponsorship every year for 10 students from mining affected area of South Goa for 4 batches starting from academic year 2025 -26 to 2031-32.

Decision: The Chairperson directed the GEC and DHE to review the proposal and accordingly devise a scholarship scheme and come up with a proper proposal.

3. Proposal for purchase of minibus for special school through District Mineral Funds (Rs.18,55,388/)

The Lokvishwas Pratistahn's Special School caters the areas in Mollem, Collem and some parts of Dharbandora. They are running one private vehicle which is not enough for them. There are almost 40- 45 students. Mostly are from the remote areas.

Decision: The Chairperson approved the proposal and recommended it to be placed before Governing Council; The MC based on suggestion from DePWD agreed to explore

the possibility of procuring a disabled-friendly or accessible bus. DePWD, Stakeholders and PMU to further deliberate on this issue and place findings in GC.

4. Project Proposal for management of type 1 diabetes

The Proposal received from Directorate of Health Services for Management of Type 1 Diabetes for Rs. 24.792 Lakhs. DHS has provided the cost of three insulin pumps, along with consumables, for three beneficiaries for a period of 12 months. The proposal estimates include the recurring cost of insulin pumps per patient for 1 year. The Managing Committee was of the opinion that Primary/ Secondary Health Care facilities in the affected areas should be strengthened first by provision of necessary staffing, equipment and supplies in health sector, convergence with the existing health care infra of local bodies, State and Central govt, group insurance scheme for health care.

Decision: The Managing Committee did not recommend the proposal, noting that only a few beneficiaries would be served while a substantial amount would be spent.

5. Construction of AWC at Moraile village at Curchorem behind Sonu Kamat Hospital. (₹ 78,39,898)

The identified site is located near the Sonu Kamat Hospital existing community area with good accessibility. Land is found to be level and suitable for construction. (Only cleaning is required). The owner is Shri. Shailesh Sanvordekar but no NOC is attached in the proposal. Water and electricity connections are available in proximity. The AWC in this catchment is near the Sanvordem bridge with only 12 active toddlers and the rent of Rs. 2000/month is paid by DWCD.

Construction of AWC at Subgiri wado near the Municipality Hall. (₹ 34,84,483).

Site selected is adjacent to the Municipality Hall, but Curchorem Cacora Municipal Council (CCMC) has already started the work of dressing room at the proposed site. No site is available at present. The AWC is rented at present with only 8 toddlers enrolled. Rent of Rs. 2000/month is paid by DWCD.

Construction of AWC at Vodlemol Cacora on the campus of the Govt. Polytechnic. (₹ 36,73,946)

Site identified on government land in the campus of the Polytechnic. However, DWCD has not formally taken over the land. The proposed site is merely 100-200 mtrs away from the 5 TDP Waste Management Plant. Health concerns may arise in future due to proximity of waste management plant. Currently AWC is at Vhodlemol in rented premises with 20 toddlers and with rent of Rs. 2000/month.

Decision: The Managing Committee after deliberation suggested that the 4 Anganwadis Centres (AWCs) sanctioned earlier in nearby areas should be utilized to their full capacity by developing them into model Anganwadis. The Department of Women and Child Development (DWCD) should also explore the possibility of converging departmental funds with SGDMF funds for this purpose. This project was not recommended to GC in its present condition.

6. Project proposals for funding support under SGDMF(T) Skill development courses

The proposal was submitted by Government College, Quepem. A total of six major courses have been proposed by the proponent. The estimated expenditure ranges from ₹17,00,000 to ₹25,00,000, in addition to ₹10,000-₹20,000 per course. The proposal was deliberated upon in the Managing Committee (MC) meeting. The MC raised queries regarding the selection criteria for beneficiaries and whether the proposal had been routed through the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), taking their concurrence into consideration.

Decision: The Government College, Quepem (GCQ) should discuss the proposal with the DHE, provide supporting documents for such a mandate from State or Centre and subsequently submit the proposal to the DMF with a detailed financial breakup and clearly defined selection criteria through DHE.

7. Project proposals for funding support under SGDMF(T), 60 Desktops and backup Systems (Rs. 61,98,300.48).

Government College Quepem has requested for the 60 Desktops and backup systems. The SGDMF has earlier supported the College by providing 25 computers. If additional computers are required, the Government College, Quepem (GCQ) should seek assistance from the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), as computers constitute a basic requirement for any college.

Decision: The Government College, Quepem (GCQ) shall seek assistance from the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE) in the first instance. Only if the DHE does not have any budgetary provision for the proposed activities only then College should approach the SGDMF. Furthermore, any proposals submitted to the SGDMF shall be routed through the DHE. The project is not recommended to GC.

8. Project proposals for funding support under SGDMF(T) setting up Skilled resource room (Rs. 12,90,000/-).

The GC, Quepem has proposed converting the existing room into a dedicated Skilled Resource Room. As the need for skill development is increasing, this kind of well-equipped skilled resource room will serve the purpose. Providing hands on training in selected skill areas such as beauty and wellness, computer applications, electrical work, etc. Proposed installation of smart boards, High Speed internet and video Conferencing equipment, Interior modifications like Painting, lighting and curtains, Electric fittings and air conditioning, Sound system and furniture. However, the representatives were not clear about the project.

Decision: The Managing Committee informed the representative to route the proposal through the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE) and to present the same with proper clarification in the next Managing Committee meeting.

9. Proposal for 12 Nos. of vehicle for the purpose of forest development protection and wildlife rescue operations. (Rs.1,18,97,560).

The proposal was submitted by the Deputy Conservator of Forests from the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. However, the proposal lacks clarity, and no proper estimates have been attached besides clarification on benefits to the affected mining community. Clarifications regarding the stations and other relevant details have also not been provided. There are no provisions for providing vehicles under the guidelines of PMKKKY.

Decision: The Managing Committee did not recommend the project due lack of the information and directed the proponent to resubmit it with proper clarification.

10. Project proposal for capacity building on production and utilization of Biofertilizer and Biopesticides in South Goa.

The Directorate of Agriculture, in association with the Goa College of Agriculture, proposed a pilot project to produce Biopesticides and Biofertilizers, train local farmers and rural youth, promote sustainable agriculture, and improve soil fertility. The estimated cost of the project is ₹10,80,790/-.

Decision: The Managing Committee recommended the proposal to GC.

11. Construction of two Culverts from PWD (Roads).



The proposal includes the reconstruction of the culvert at Dattawadi in V.P. Sanvordem (Sanvordem Constituency) for ₹46,32,900/- and the replacement of the pipe culvert with a box culvert on MDR 52 at Vakikulan in V.P. Collem Sigao (Sanvordem Constituency) for ₹49,69,600/-. **It was noted that the culverts sanctioned earlier are yet to be commenced.**

Decision: The PWD (Roads) was directed to first complete the culverts sanctioned earlier by the SGDMF. The proposal was recommended to GC.

12.New Application for Adaptive vehicles

The proponent is Freddy Lopes and he has applied for assistive vehicle license. He is expected to get it in the coming month. He Doesn't have any existing assistive vehicle donated by any Govt or non Govt agency. He is from Jambaulim, Sanguem Goa. The MC deliberated on the Assistive Vehicles and felt that individual cases need not be brought before MC for approval as GC has already sanctioned Rs.41.90 Lakh for purchase of assistive vehicles in the past. The DePWD and DMF secretariat should handle the Identification and cross verification of the beneficiaries and finalization.

Decision: The Chairperson approved the request and informed that there is no need to place such requests before the Managing Committee or Governing Council, as the project for 41 bikes has already been sanctioned. Once the sanctioned funds are exhausted, the project can be re-proposed or additional funds may be requested from MC& GC.

13.Proposals Received Directly/ without proposal format

- New English High School – Request for the bus (Without proposal format and Not routed through DoE).
- Bhausahab Bandodkar Shikshan Sauntha Dharbandora-Installation of Smart Boards in Classrooms (Not Routed through DoE)
- Government College Khandola- Request for the bus (Not routed through DHE)
- Somnath English High School- Providing School Bus, Renovation of School Hall, painting of School building and classroom. (Neither in proposal format nor routed through DoE).
- Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Canacona- (Not in mining area)
- Lokvishwas Pratisthan - The proposal for the bus is directly submitted.(To be routed through DePWD)

Decision: The proposals were either not received from the parent department or were not submitted in the prescribed SGDMF format; therefore, proposals are not favourably considered. The same may be communicated to the proponent by PMU.

14.Fencing of Abandoned Laterite Quarries

The earlier proposal for fencing of abandoned laterite quarries was reverted back to SGDMF for consideration. However, the same was not considered by MC in its present format as there are no benefits for the local community or environment and does not fit into the guidelines of PMKKKY 2024.

Any Other Agenda with permission of Chair

- The MC was informed that the office of the South Goa District Mineral Foundation in room no. 30 of South Goa Collectorate Ground Floor is refurbished to suit the requirement of the public with a cost of ₹1.98 Lakh. There are few more requirements like drinking water, sitting for public etc.
